



Announcement of Faculty of Associated Medical Sciences,

Advanced Data and Statistical Analysis Consultation Grant
for Graduate Students 2025

Faculty of Associated Medical Sciences, Chiang Mai University is committed to advancing social sustainability in healthcare through cutting-edge research and innovations. In alignment with international standards, we strive to cultivate graduate students with a strong foundation in advanced research skills and high-quality education.

To support this mission, the faculty offers partial financial assistance to graduate students pursuing expert consultation in advanced data and statistical analysis. This initiative is designed to elevate the quality of research proposals and strengthen the potential for publication in high-impact academic journals.

1. Objectives

1.1 To support expert consultation in advanced data and statistical analysis essential for graduate students' thesis research.

1.2 To enhance the academic quality and reliability of thesis research according to statistical standards

2. Eligibility

2.1 Applicants must be currently enrolled in a Ph.D. or Master's program within the Faculty of Associated Medical Sciences' postgraduate studies. Their **thesis proposal must have already received formal approval from the Faculty Graduate Education Executive Committee (GEEC).**

2.2 The proposed consultation topic and the consultant's area of expertise must be **directly relevant to the student's approved research proposal.** The consultation **must be endorsed by both the principal thesis advisor and the Graduate Program Executive Committee (GPEC).**

3. Consideration Criteria

The number of grants available per semester/academic year is limited and will be announced in the official call for applications. Funding will be considered on

a first come, first served basis, based on applications submitted for the GEEC's monthly meetings. If the number of applicants exceeds the available grants, the following criteria will apply:

- 1) Priority based on academic urgency:

Level of Urgency	Conditions
Normal	Standard academic progress
Urgent	Study period has exceeded the program's prescribed study duration
Critical	Approaching academic disqualification within the current semester

- 2) Priority will be given to applicants who have not previously received this grant.
- 3) The GEEC is responsible for the final review and approval of all grant requests.

4. Financial support

Students are eligible for consultation support up to 2,000 THB, with a maximum rate of 600 THB per hour. An additional 1,000 THB may be requested based on specific academic needs, subject to approval by both the GEEC.

5. Required documents for application

Applicants must submit the following documents to the Academic Services and Student Development Sections by 14 days after completing their consultation session. Approved funds must be reimbursed no later than September 15th of each academic year.

- 5.1 A completed application form, including opinion and signature of the principal thesis advisor.
- 5.2 Approval of the GPEC and signature of the Committee Chair
- 5.3 Expert's Curriculum Vitae (CV)
- 5.4 A payment voucher and a copy of the national ID card from the expert
