
COMPREHENSIVE EXAMINATION



CONDITIONS

Comprehensive examination is used to test general knowledge, concepts and content integration capability, and knowledge application capability in problem solving. The student must enroll all courses specified in the curriculum and pass all required courses with at least grade C.

- 1. Comprehensive examination is compulsory for type 3 and type 4 master's degree programs.
- 2. The student must apply for comprehensive examination, with approval by a thesis advisor.
- 3. Comprehensive examination committee comprise of at least 3 examiners from full-time graduate school instructors who appointed by the Graduate Education Executive Committee.
- 4. After the comprehensive examination has been done, the Chair of examiners must report the result of examination to the graduate school within 1 week.
- 5. The student who fails comprehensive examination shall receive one more right to take a reexamination by submitting a request form and pay the fee 500 THB for the master's student and 1000 THB for Doctoral degree

A student who fails comprehensive examination, the student status will be terminated.
