Subject: Criteria and Operating Procedure for Thesis Publication (3<sup>rd</sup> Issue)

According to the Regulation of Chiang Mai University on Graduate Education 2559 B.E., clause no. 29.6: a thesis work must be published or at least accepted to publish in a journal, media, printed matter, registered a petty patent or patent, or other ways of publication that are accepted in the field of study as specified by the graduate school, on each level and/or type of study. The Graduate School has issued the Announcement of Graduate School no. 37/2559, Subject: Criteria and Operating Procedure for Thesis Publication, and the Announcement of Graduate School no. 45/2560, Subject: Criteria and Operating Procedure for Thesis Publication  $Q^{\text{nd}}$  Issue)

The Graduate School Executive Committee (GSEC), at the meeting no. 20/2561 on 19<sup>th</sup> October 2561 B.E., has approved to change some criteria and operating procedure for thesis publication as follows:

- 1. Clause no. 2.7 of the Announcement of the Graduate School no. 37/2559, Subject: Criteria and Operating Procedure for Thesis Publication, is abolished and replaced by the following statement:
- "2.7 A patent generated by an invention or design which is already given a patent number and is a part of thesis work that the student is involved and shared the patent ownership can be used instead of 1 international journal publication."

This announcement is effective for any new open or new revision of a graduate program starting from the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester of the academic year 2561 (2018).
