

Announcement of Faculty of Associated Medical Sciences, Chiang Mai University The Manuscript Publication Reward for Graduate Students

Faculty of Associated Medical Sciences, Chiang Mai University strives to empower social sustainability in healthcare towards creating cutting-edge research and innovations. We are committed to nurturing graduate students with high quality education and advanced research skills, aligned with international standards. We provide funding from inception to publication of a research study. All graduate students will receive some seed budget for their research project. Additionally, students may apply for the Manuscript Publication Reward if their manuscript is accepted for publication in a Quartile 1 (Q1) or Quartile 2 (Q2) journals.

1. Objective

To support and motivate graduate students to conduct rigorous, high-quality research and publishing their works in esteemed academic journals.

2. Qualifications

- Applicants must be currently enrolled as graduate student in the Faculty of Associated Medical Sciences, Chiang Mai University.
- 2. The dissertation/thesis proposal must have received approval from the Faculty Graduate Education Executive Committee.

3. Consideration criteria

- 1. The applicant must have a manuscript that has been accepted for publication in a Q1 or Q2 journal.
- 2. The publication must be directly related to the applicant's thesis and must be utilized as part of the graduation requirements.

4. Financial support for the Manuscript Publication Reward

The faculty will allocate grants to eligible applicants who meet the criteria based on the order of submission.

A portion of the research budget will be reimbursed to those who published their research in Q1 or Q2 journals, as follows:

- Quartile 1: 15,000 THB
- Quartile 2: 5,000 THB

5. Required documents for application

Applicants must submit the following documents to the Educational Services Unit, by the 15th day of every month:

- 1) A completed application form for the Manuscript Publication Reward.
- 2) A manuscript or full paper, along with the article acceptance letter from the journal.
- 3) Proof of the quartile (Q) ranking of the published journal, as listed on the SJR or ISI website.
- 4) **Receipts of payment** related to expenses incurred for research project associated with the accepted manuscript.

6. Consideration and decision

The review and decision regarding the granting of the Manuscript Publication Reward will be made by the Chairman of Faculty Graduate Education Executive Committee, and the decision shall be considered final.
