

Announcement of Faculty of Associated Medical Sciences, Chiang Mai University The Research Presentation Grant for Doctoral Students

Faculty of Associated Medical Sciences, Chiang Mai University is dedicated to advancing social sustainability in healthcare through cutting-edge research and innovations. We are committed to nurture graduate students with high quality education and advanced research skills, aligned with international standards. To uphold these standards, the faculty provide partial financial support for research presentations. All Ph.D. students are required to present their research in oral or poster presentation at an international conference or symposium before graduation. This funding provides doctoral students with the opportunity to present their research at an international conference or symposium, enabling them to share their work with a global academic community.

1. Objectives

- 1. To provide partial financial support for doctoral students in delivering an oral or poster presentations on their research works.
- 2. To provide doctoral students with valuable learning experience by engaging with speakers and experts who share similar academic goals and interests.

2. Qualifications

- 1. Applicants must be currently enrolled as a Ph.D. student in Biomedical Sciences Program.
- 2. The dissertation proposal must have been approved by the Faculty Graduate Education Executive Committee.
- 3. The proposed international conference presentation must be an integral part of the student's dissertation and must receive an advisor approval.

3. Consideration criteria

- 1. An applicant must be **the first author** of the presentation.
- 2. The international conference or symposium must be **related to the applicant's field of study** and must **receive an approval from their major advisor**.

Remark: Each student is eligible to apply for this grant only once.

4. Financial support for oral or poster presentation

The grant amount varies depending on the location of the conference or symposium, as follows:

- Domestic Activity (within Chiang Mai province): Up to 2,000 THB
- Domestic Activity (within Thailand):
 Up to 4,000 THB
- Foreign Country Activity (outside Thailand): Up to 10,000 THB

5. Required documents for application

The applicant must submit the following documents to the Educational Services Unit, by the 15th day of every month.

- 1) A completed application form for the Research Presentation Grant.
- 2) An acceptance letter/email from the international conference or symposium.
- 3) Evidence of participation (photo, certificate, etc.)

6. Consideration and decision

The review and decision regarding the granting of the Manuscript Publication Reward will be made by the Chairman of Faculty Graduate Education Executive Committee, and the decision shall be considered final.
