Subject: Research Presentation Grants for Doctoral Students

Faculty of Associated Medical Sciences, Chiang Mai University strives to empower social sustainability in healthcare towards creating cutting-edge research and innovations. We are committed to nurture our graduate students with high quality education and advanced research skills based on international standards. Before graduation, all Ph.D. students must have an oral/poster presentation in the international conference or symposium.

1. Objective

1. To support doctoral students to deliver an oral or poster presentations about their research works
2. To give doctoral students the experience to learn and share from speakers and experts who have similar goals and interests

2. Applicant's Qualification

1. Must be a current Ph.D. student in Biomedical Sciences Program
2. Dissertation proposal must have been approved by the Faculty Executive Committee of Graduate studies
3. The proposed international conference presentation must be a part of the student's dissertation and obtain an advisor's approval

3. Consideration Criteria

1. An applicant must be the first author of this presentation
2. International conference/symposium must relate to the applicant's field of study and obtain an approval by a major advisor

Remark: Each student can apply this grant only once

4. Financial support for Oral or Poster Presentation

The amount of grant depends on the location of the conference or symposium as follows;

Locations	Amount
Domestic Activity (within Chiang Mai province); not over than	1,500 THB
Domestic Activity (within Thailand); not over than	2,500 THB
Foreign Country Activity (outside Thailand); not over than	5,000 THB

5. Required documents for application

The applicant must submit the following documents to the Educational services, by the 15th day of every month.

- 1) A completed application form for research presentation grant
- 2) An acceptance letter/email from the conference/symposium
